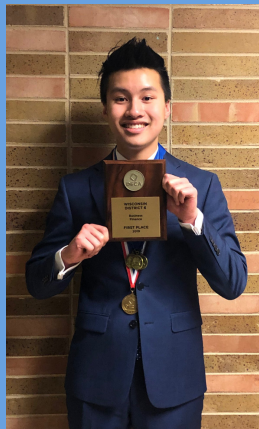

**STATE QUALIFIERS: 28**

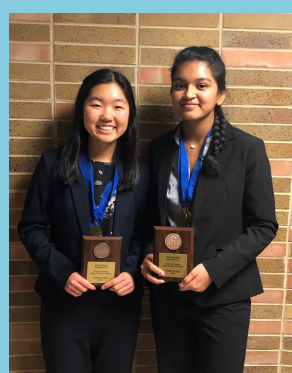

**42** TOP 4 FINISHES

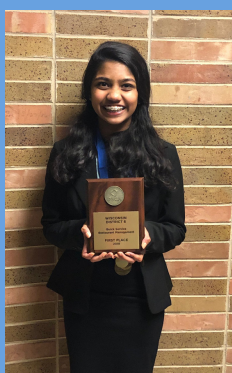
Forty-two of BC DECA's competing members placed in the top four for their event. Each received a plaque.
